Dear Agents,

The LCBO has completed a review of our standard freight rates.

Standard freight rates apply to products sold through the VINTAGES and Specialty Services channels. Please remember that suppliers can take advantage of the FCA* rate, which gives them the option of delivering directly to a LCBO Consolidation warehouse, thereby reducing the standard freight rate. Another significant advantage of opting for the FCA rate is that it eliminates the Ex-Cellar** minimum case quantity requirement.

The standard rates will be applied to **all orders received on or after February 4, 2018.**

*FCA is the term used when product is delivered by the supplier, at their own expense, to the forwarder's warehouse for consolidation and shipment.

**Ex-Cellar denotes product that is picked up at the supplier location, with freight costs paid by the LCBO. The minimum Ex Cellar case quantities are shown on the attached standard rate sheet. Please note that Ex Cellar terms may have additional costs applied if the minimum case quantities are not met. Ex Cellar rates are offered for only those countries with a significant number of orders per year. However, if there is a specific request, we will attempt to establish a rate and will advise on the cost per case.

- 1) No quotes are provided for areas in which the LCBO has less than 10 orders in a calendar year.
 - 2) For areas that have established Excellar quotes the suggested order quantity must be ordered. Any orders placed for less than the suggested order quantity will result in a higher freight cost.
 - 3) The LCBO cannot guarantee that each country/consolidation facility will at any given time have sufficient order quantities to allow for a consolidation from that country/consolidation facility. Insufficient volumes or case quantities from a consolidation facility may result in additional freight costs being applicable.
 - 4) Suggested order is simply a recovery of the minimum Excellar charge at a specific consolidation location i.e., when the average order size goes down, the suggested order quantity goes up to recover the minimum charge assuming no change in the underlying rates.
