#### **GLOBAL PULSE**

## Italy

• Strike in Napoli port involving terminal operators and truckers. As part of alternate solutions, we are leveraging other ports such as Salerno or Gioia Tauro and re-routed orders via Salerno, though with additional 4 days of transit time.

## **NEW ZEALAND**

• Seeing reduced Metroport Rail Service schedule in Port of Tauranga affecting service to USA trades. As of now, we have a feeder service from Auckland to Port Chalmers specifically for LCBO bookings. Some shipments may be impacted leading to longer transit times.

#### France

• French National federation of Ports & Docks calling for 24-hour strike few days in the month of June. These repeated work stoppages could slow down day to day operations. We will provide updates and advise accordingly if LCBO freight is impacted.

#### Asia

• We continue to see capacity constraints regardless of the SS line, we are pushing for set allocation per week with our main carriers for that region.

# **North America**

• There are currently no North American port disruptions that are impacting LCBO orders.
