## **GLOBAL PULSE**

France

A national strike in France continues to impede transportation causing disruption and port delay. We continue to work with our Forwarder to move freight and minimize impact on LCBO orders.

## **CANADIAN PORTS**

Montreal – 7-day dwell Halifax - no delays

## **CANADIAN PUBLIC SERVANTS**

More than 155,000 federal public servants are on strike after the federal government and the Public Service Alliance of Canada (PSAC) failed to reach a deal before the deadline. At this point there has been no impact on LCBO business.

## **QUEBEC SPRING THAW**

For the thaw period of 2023, the predicted dates of the load restriction period is from Monday, March 20 to Friday, May 19. Trucks that will be transporting full beer loads must be cut as 22 pallets maximum to comply with the weight restriction. Please note that Spring Thaw end date is subject to change depending on the weather.
