GLOBAL PULSE

Israel

• The flow of freight out of Israel continues to be impacted by the conflict and further developments remain unpredictable during these exceptionally difficult times.

South America- Argentina and Chile

• Severe drought in the Panama Region continues to create a low water situation in the Panama Canal resulting in reduced vessel traffic and draft restrictions. This note is for awareness only as LCBO freight has not been impacted at this point.

Lastly, if the current piracy and violence issues in the Red Sea/Suez Canal region continue and the situation goes unresolved for any length of time, there will be a potential for service disruption. Some ocean carriers have started temporarily suspending service and/or altering their routes to avoid passing through the area. We will provide updates accordingly.

North America

• There are currently no North American port disruptions that are impacting LCBO orders.
