This April, we launched the fifth year of our annual environmental campaign with Tree Canada. Together we raised \$949K to support the planting of 177,000+ trees across Canada, adding to the 615,000+ trees we’ve helped plant since 2022!

Common Digs Community Homestead
(Thunder Bay): This initiative is transforming a former horse farm into a restorative orchard and care farm, creating an inclusive, nature-based space where young adults with developmental disabilities can connect, learn, and thrive.

Northern Roots Regenerative Farm (Blackstock): This project will establish a regenerative farm that supports life skills development, wellness, and environmental stewardship for the community, including special-needs youth and adults. Participants will learn through tree care, seed collection, wildflower reseeding, soil regeneration, and other educational initiatives.

Georgian College (Barrie): This project enhances biodiversity by increasing the variety of plant species on the Georgian College campus. Planting fruit-bearing trees and shrubs will provide seasonal food sources and habitat opportunities, attracting pollinators, birds, and other small wildlife.

Since 2021, our **Love Pairs with Everything** campaign has been supporting the safety, inclusion, health, and well-being of Ontario’s 2SLGBTQI+ communities.

This year’s campaign proceeds will help address some of the most pressing challenges 2SLGBTQI+ communities are facing, including housing instability, food insecurity, barriers to healthcare, and threats to human rights. The **\$1.5M raised** will support organizations delivering critical services and community-based solutions where they are needed most. Casey House will provide nutritious meals, continue to connect people with Casey House’s HIV expertise in person and virtually, and increase harm reduction services.



The 519 will provide marginalized 2SLGBTQI+ community members with crisis support, such as food drop-in programs, access to emergency supplies, and referrals to medical and mental health services.



Egale will conduct research on the housing realities of 2SLGBTQI+ people in Ontario, and bolster 2SLGBTQI+ inclusion and well-being through training for child welfare staff and educators.
