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GENERAL GUIDELINES:

All customers who import shipments of unsolicited beverage alcohol products or who place orders for beverage alcohol products with the Specialty Services Department of the Liquor Control Board of Ontario ("LCBO") should be aware of the following LCBO laboratory testing guidelines:

- (1) All Specialty Services and unsolicited orders are subject to LCBO laboratory analysis.
- (2) All orders for beverage alcohol products which are intended for resale by a licensee to the general public are tested to ensure that they are in compliance with all applicable laws, regulatory requirements and LCBO chemical and labelling standards ("LCBO standards").
- (3) Any beverage alcohol product which contravenes any applicable laws, regulations or LCBO standards will be rejected by the laboratory and returned to the vendor (at the vendor's expense) or, under Canada Customs supervision, will be destroyed.

NOTE:

- (1) Shipments of beverage alcohol products which were not ordered by the LCBO are subject to LCBO laboratory analysis. The LCBO reserves the right to charge a fee for any laboratory analysis and/or processing performed on unsolicited shipments.
- (2) A processing charge of \$55 per product exemption will be invoiced to the Agent (as updated from time to time).
- (3) The LCBO reserves the right to (i) test a product at any time; (ii) refuse a request for exemption from testing requirements up until the time the products are released to the public; and (ii) test any product which may be in contravention of any applicable laws, regulatory requirements or LCBO standards.



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Lab Testing and Waiver Policy – Personal Exemption

The LCBO tests all beverage alcohol products which it imports and sells to licensees for resale to the public at large. Where a non-licensee (a person who is not licensed or approved to sell liquor by either the AGCO or the LCBO) orders liquor for his/her own personal use, he/she may request the LCBO for an exemption from laboratory testing ("Personal Exemption") and in this regard will be required to sign a Release and Indemnification acknowledging that he/she will be fully responsible for all damages suffered by himself/herself or any person as a result of or in connection with the liquor products that have not been tested, whether as a result of tampering with the product or otherwise. He/she must also agree to indemnify the LCBO with respect to any claim, action, etc. of any kind made against the LCRO by any person in connection with injury of damages which result from the liquor that has not been tested.
