# **NISS Shipping Container Review**

A physical shipping container used to transport selling units with all case markings and SCC-14 barcodes is required for review. The shipping container sample must be an exact representation of the packaging that will be arriving at our warehouses.

## \*Mock-ups or artwork will not be accepted\*

#### **Cartons:**

- 1) A fully constructed carton including partitions, where applicable, are required.
- 2) For information on mandatory shipping container markings, please see our Product Packaging Standards, linked here: <u>LCBO PRODUCT (doingbusinesswithlcbo.com)</u>

### Trays:

- 1) A fully constructed tray is required.
- 2) All trays must include selling units for measurement purposes.
- 3) All trays are required to be shrink-wrapped.

- Please complete and attach form **LCB 2102e** "Request for Shipping Container Examination" to your shipping container.
- All Shipping Containers are to be submitted through your Category Administrator
- The package must be addressed to the ATTN of your Category (i.e., Beer & Cider) and your Admin.
